Find the rhyme



- Rescue Crew is full of rhyming words, like 'rat and cat', or 'soggy and boggy'. You could play a game together, finding words that rhyme. Does anything rhyme with your child's name?
- Another fun activity could be pretending to be the different vehicles in the book and making up the sounds they might make. For example, a car goes 'brum'.

Wheels on the bus

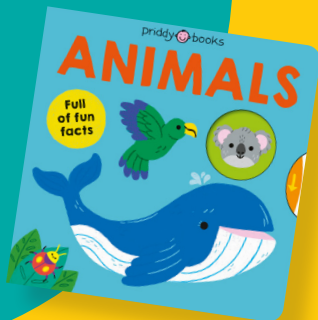


The wheels on the bus go round and round
