Make Owl's wings together

Before you start

- Cut out Owl's body
- Find a space so Owl's wings can grow (noticeboard, wall or window would work well)

What you'll need

- Coloured paper for handprints
- Pens, pencils or crayons
- Child-safe scissors and a grown-up to help

To make the wings

- Trace around each child's hand on the paper and cut it out
- Everyone could write their name or decorate their handprint
- Add each handprint to Owl to create eye-catching wings
- Keep adding handprints over the weeks as you run Bookstart Storytime sessions!
