



Activity idea:

Play 'Toss the pancake'

- Croc makes pancakes in the book. Pancakes are made in a pan and often get tossed into the air and caught again. You could pretend to toss and catch a pancake together.
- Together, you could imagine your perfect pancake meal. What would you put on it?
- You could also look at the pots, pans and utensils you have at home, comparing their different sizes, and pretend to make pancakes like Croc.

Play 'What can you hear?'

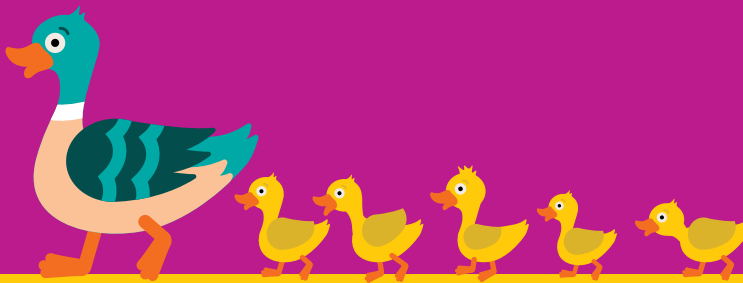


- In the book, the children go to the park. Next time you go to the park or for a walk together, you could listen out for the sounds that are in the story.
