By signing up to join Stride for Stories (the “Event”), I confirm I understand and agree to the following terms and conditions.

General

- BookTrust has carried out a risk assessment for this event and will comply with relevant health and safety standards. However, as this is a virtual challenge, you are responsible for ensuring your chosen activity is safe and suitable for you.
- You agree to follow all relevant local laws and codes, including the Countryside Code or Scottish Outdoor Access Code if applicable.
- You agree to only use lawful means to fundraise and not to do anything that is likely to harm BookTrust’s reputation.
- BookTrust is committed to equality and non-discrimination in line with the Equality Act 2010.

Your Health and Safety

- You confirm you are medically and physically fit and understand that you take part in this event at your own risk.
- BookTrust will not be held responsible for any injury or illness related to your training or participation.
- If you have any medical conditions that could be affected by exercise, or if you are in doubt about your health, you must consult your doctor before participating.
- BookTrust does not provide insurance for participants. You are advised to arrange your own insurance if required.

Registration

- You must be aged 18 or over to register unless you have parental/guardian consent. Parents/guardians must email fundraising@booktrust.org.uk confirming consent and responsibility for compliance with these Terms.
- BookTrust reserves the right to refuse participation if health and safety requirements are not met or if participation may harm BookTrust’s reputation.
